Is your church membership growing? How about your Sunday school? How many young people attend each Sunday? You may say that those who attend are growing in their walk with the Lord, but our numbers are down and particularly in our Sunday schools. We have the ANSWER FOR YOUR CHURCH!..... CRT (CHRISTIAN RELEASED TIME). This is a program that allows public school children in Pennsylvania to attend religious training for one hour per week for 36 weeks. While in school time, they may be walked to a close location, off the school grounds, to learn about Jesus Christ. We don't know how much longer we will have this freedom to share our Lord, knowing the way our country is going ... so we urge you to plan now to start up a CRT Class in September and train as many youth as possible in the Philadelphia area. What a difference it will make in our city of Brotherly Love! Train the child and allow the child to help their parents and grandparents to come to know the Lord.
